

Command Line Guide

Updated April 23, 2018 for use with PCMark 7
Professional Edition v1.4.0

Usage

Run the program from a command line that was started as an administrator, (right-click on the *cmd* shortcut, and select *Run as Administrator*).

PCMark7Cmd.exe [options]

<u>PCMark 7 Professional Edition</u> license required for command line use.

Options

Command	Description
all[=on =off]	Run all suites (default off).
pcmark[=on =off]	Run PCMark suite (default off).
lightweight[=on =off]	Run Lightweight suite (default off).
productivity[=on =off]	Run Productivity suite (default off).
entertainment[=on =off]	Run Entertainment suite (default off).
creativity[=on =off]	Run Creativity suite (default off).
computation[=on =off]	Run Computation suite (default off).
systemstorage[=on =off]	Run System storage suite (default off).
secondarystorage[=on =off]	Run Secondary storage suite (default off).
systeminfo[=on =off]	Collect SystemInfo (default off).
storagepath= <path></path>	The path for the Secondary storage suite, for example D:\
systeminfo[=on =off]	Collect SystemInfo (default on).
out= <file.pcmark-7-result></file.pcmark-7-result>	Save results in the file.
in= <file.pcmark-7-result></file.pcmark-7-result>	Load results from the file (only for submitting or exporting).
submit[=on =off]	Send results to PCMark.com (default off).
export= <file.xml></file.xml>	Export results to the XML file.
view	View results.
register= <product key=""></product>	Register PCMark 7 with the given key.

unregister	Unregister PCMark 7.

Examples

Run all benchmark suites and save result to myresults.pcmark-7-result

```
PCMark7Cmd.exe --all --out=myresults.pcmark-7-result
```

Run only the secondary storage suite, targeting E:\ drive without scanning SystemInfo hardware configuration data and save results to myresults.pcmark-7-result

```
PCMark7Cmd.exe --secondarystorage=on --storagepath=e:\
--systeminfo=off --out=myresults.pcmark-7-result
```

Run the default PCMark suite and export the result to myresult.xml

```
PCMark7Cmd.exe --pcmark --export=myresult.xml
```

Sample script

```
SET RESULTDIR=%CD%
pushd C:
cd "C:\Program Files\Futuremark\PCMark 7\bin"
PCMark7Cmd.exe --all
--out=%RESULTDIR%\pcmark_7_result.pcmark-7-result
popd
```
